About the Street Survival Guide:

The Street Survival Guide provides information on resources available in Victoria to survive, and move on from, homelessness. Created by a group of volunteers with street-life experience, the guide includes resources for single, youth, families, seniors and aboriginal people.

The guide is the Coalition's first social inclusion based project. As a result of this project a group of individuals have come forward as ambassadors of the Coalition – eager to work and consult on future projects.
