# **Droplet Precautions**

### SIGNAGE

Droplet Precautions sign must be posted on the door and next to patient's bed in multi-bed rooms. (See Droplet Precautions poster, Catalogue #0040508, on the Precaution Signs navigation bar on the Infection Prevention and Control website.)

During periods of high census, patients/residents on droplet precautions might be placed in a two or four-bed room. A green Droplet Precaution sign will be posted outside the room as well as on the curtain of the affected patient within that room.

- Single Room: the doors to single rooms can be kept open
- When a single-patient room is not available, consultation with infection prevention and control personnel is recommended to assess the various risks associated with other patient placement options (e.g. cohorting patients/residents with the same infection, keeping the patient with an existing roommate)
- Spatial separation of at least two meters (6 feet or more) from patient to curtain and drawing the curtain between patient beds is especially important for patients/residents in multi-bed rooms with infections transmitted by the droplet route
