

The BladeRunners Program

About

The John Howard Society of Victoria has administered the BladeRunners program for 27 years, and we continue to embrace the original model. BladeRunners is an employment program which helps disadvantaged young people aged 15-30 years of age obtain and sustain full-time employment in a variety of different industries. The program was created in 1994 during the construction of General Motors Place in Vancouver, with the purpose of matching construction industry needs with opportunities for inner-city disadvantaged young adults. To be Eligible for this program participants must;

- Be between the ages of 15 and 30
- Cannot be enrolled in school full time
- Have a valid Social Insurance Number (SIN)
- Be looking for part or full time work

Program Completion Bonus

Upon completion of the program participants will receive a \$200 bonus.

Additionally, you can receive \$100 for every referral that completes the programs (up to 10 referrals).



The Voyager Program

About

The Voyager Employment program supports persons with self-identified disabilities (15 years +) who are experiencing barriers to employment. The objective of the program is to prepare participants to acquire new skills and enhance existing skills, so they find long term success in finding and keeping good jobs

Activities Offered

- Employment Skills Training (3 weeks)
- Enhanced Employer Support
- Resume Building and Job Coaching Support
- Workshops and Certifications

Living Wage

Participants are paid BC Minimum wage for training hours (Up to \$100 per in class* days)

Wage Subsidy Incentive for Employers

Any employer who hires a Voyager graduate can receive a wage subsidy off of their employees hourly rate. This incentive for employers improves the chances of our graduates getting hired in a shorter period of time.

Wage Subsidy is offered for up to 300 hours or 12 weeks
