



Unit Types

Mat: Sleeping pads or mattresses in shared rooms or spaces, used to accommodate individuals during crises or severe weather.

Bed/dorm: Shared rooms or spaces, housing two or more beds for individuals who are not related.

Studio: Self-contained units typically consisting of one main room serving as a combined living area, bedroom, and kitchenette.

1-Bedroom: Apartments or units with a separate bedroom, usually in addition to a living room, kitchen, and bathroom.

2-Bedroom: Apartments or units with two separate bedrooms, suitable for small families or roommates.

3+ Bedroom: Apartments or units with three separate bedrooms, suitable for larger families.
